Dr Bosman is a South African trained medical doctor. He graduated from the University of Stellenbosch in 2002 and gained his AMC in 2011.

Recently, Dr Bosman’s focus has turned to Palliative Care provision within a General Practice environment. Dr Bosman is currently working at the National Cannabinoid Clinics in the CBD of Sydney where General Practitioners and Specialist Health Care Professionals deliver specialized care and individualized treatment plans.
