ADHD in Adults

Sally is a senior lecturer in Paediatrics at the University of Sydney and has more than 20 years experience of working with children and young people with ADHD and their families, Graduating from The University of Cambridge before training for Paediatrics in Australia, Sally did her MD (similar to a PhD) investigating the effects of stimulant medication on growth and physical development in children with ADHD. Although the bulk of her work has been in private practice, she is establishing a Lifespan ADHD Clinic in the community, to be run by specialists and GPs. The concept is to have an ADHD service without any age restrictions. The upskilled GPs would also treat children and adults with ADHD in their own practices, increasing the capacity for meeting the community need for ADHD treatment, and promoting continuity of care for people at all stages of their development.
