Dr Samuel Dance is a comprehensive general ophthalmologist with sub-specialty training in Cataract and Glaucoma surgery, and medical conditions of the retina including Diabetic Retinopathy, Macular Degeneration and Vein occlusions. He has been a reviewer for the Journal of Glaucoma, lectured at both the University of Sydney, and University of New South Wales, and been an investigator for multiple international clinical trials assessing innovative ocular therapies. He has been appointed to the Ophthalmology Liaison Committee at Glaucoma Australia and is a fellow of the Royal Australian & New Zealand College of Ophthalmologists.
